- ✓ Simplified sign-in for Fund workstations connected to the network using Start/Remote Access Services/Citrix Receiver Internal Single Sign-On.



- Citrix Receiver External: For connecting from outside the office network or from guest wireless.
- Citrix Receiver Internal-Single-Sign-On: Login without having to provide credentials while on the internal network.
- Citrix Receiver Internal: Use if you are sharing a machine with another user and would like to login to Citrix with your credentials.





Tips on the New Start Menu

Make the Start menu work for you:

Pin applications: Search for any application/program and right click.
 Choose Pin to Start to have easy access from the Start menu, OR for the most frequently used applications, choose Pin to Taskbar for single-click access from your desktop.



- Group pinned applications: Click and drag to group pinned applications, or create a new group name, above a pinned application, right click and select Name Groups.
- Navigate back to desktop: In the Start menu and want to return to your desktop? Tap the Esc key.

Citrix for Mac

In the past, Citrix was only supported on Safari. Now, Mac users may access Citrix from various browsers, including Chrome.


