

USING PULSE SECURE TO CONNECT TO THE FUND

What is Pulse Secure?

Pulse Secure VPN (Virtual Private Network) is a secure means of connecting to the Fund's network. With Pulse Secure, you connect to the network using any Internet connection and your SecurID access RSA token.

Accessing and Logging into IMF Pulse Secure

- 1. Ensure that you have an internet connection.
- 2. Click Start / All Programs / Remote Access Services / Pulse Secure.
- 3. Click Connect. (Figure 1)
- 4. Enter your network username and network password and click **Connect**. (Figure 2)
- Enter your RSA SecurID PIN and token, and click Connect. (Figure 3)
- 6. A green check mark will appear when a successful connection has been made. (Figure 4)


Launching Applications (Fund Laptop)

Once connected, you can:

- Open Outlook to access your email and calendar and Lync.
- Utilize web-based applications (e.g., IMF intranet, TRACES, Learning Portal, SNOW).
- Log into Citrix (https://intremote.imf.org) to access eDocs DM and network drives.

Signing Off IMF Pulse Secure

- 1. Close all open applications.
- Switch to Pulse Secure and click **Disconnect**. (Figure 4)



Notes

- The network password is case sensitive.
- After 5 hours/12 hours (HQ/Remote) of inactivity, the system will time out and log you out.
- Be sure to close all applications and windows before signing off to ensure a complete log off.
