As we prepare for the virtual 2021 Spring Meetings, allow us to highlight **the launch of IMF's new Climate Change Indicators Dashboard** (CID). It provides access to climate-related data for macroeconomic and financial analysis, including economic and climate indicators such as greenhouse gas emissions; financial, physical and transition risk indicators such as carbon footprint-adjusted loans; cross-border indicators; and policy indicators. The dashboard was built in collaboration with international organizations and aims to support policy makers and the general public, in addition to the IMF's work.
